

The concept of minimally invasive neurosurgery was created by our friend Axel Pernesky during the 80's, and the possibility of founding an International Society to coordinate efforts in that direction was a dream of Axel that unfortunately he could not realize.

As a tribute to Axel we decided with a group of colleagues from around the world in 2012 to create an International Scientific Society, (ISMINS) that would enable the research and development of techniques based on modern technologies that could reduce the risks of traditional neurosurgical procedures in our patients.

So in 2011 was founded in Florence (Italy), the International Society of Minimally Invasive Neurosurgery with the Chair of Prof. Yoko Kato from Japan and the first International Congress was scheduled in March 2012 from 20 to 23 in Florence Italy under the chairmanship of Prof. Gianni Broggi

The creation of this new website will certainly greatly contribute to the diffusion of the activities of ISMINS and will develop through the web a basis for the education of young neurosurgeons on modern practice of minimally invasive neurosurgery.
